Class A Aircraft Mishap

Aircraft was operating in an area near the DMZ approx. 52 miles N.E. of Seoul Korea. While on an approach with a sling load the aircraft sustained loss of power on one engine and they were unable to successfully land the aircraft.

One (1) Korean soldier on the ground was fatally injured and (1) one Korean soldier on the ground was seriously injured. There were no reported injuries to the (4) four crewmen onboard the aircraft.

The aircraft sustained major damage but no fire was reported. The status of the aircraft is unknown at this time.

The U.S. Army Safety Center has dispatched a team but there is no request for technical assistance from Boeing Vertol at this time.
